

## Salem Press

Salem Press is a database available to patrons of the Preble County District Library. Through the database, you have access to 20 titles covering topics in literature, history, science, and health.

You can access this resource from the library or from your home computer.

### What you Need:

- Preble County District Library Card
- A computer with internet access

### To Access the Database:

1. Go to [preblelibrary.org](http://preblelibrary.org)
2. Click on “Research”.
3. Scroll down the Reference Desk page until you see “Science”. Click on “Science”. A drop down menu will appear.
4. Click on “Salem Press”. You will be redirected to the databases main page. You will then need to enter in your library card number if you are accessing the database from a location other than a branch of the Preble County District Library.

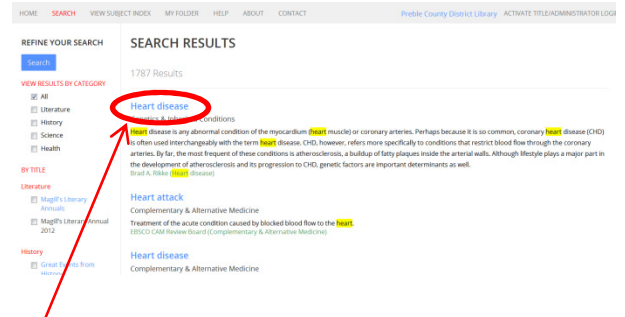

## To Perform a Basic Search:

1. From the Salem Press Home Page, click in the “Enter Keyword” box at the center of the page.
2. Enter in your search term and hit “enter” on the keyboard to perform the search.
3. The next page will display your search results. The article name is displayed in blue. Underneath the article name is the name of the book in which the article is found. There will also be a brief description of the article’s content. Click on the blue article name to view the entire article.



## To Create an Article Citation:

1. If you have found an article that you need to cite in a school assignment, click on “Article Citation” on the left side of the page.
2. A window will appear on the screen displaying the article’s citation in MLA, APA, and Chicago Style.
3. Click on the style that you want to use. You can either save or print the citation.
