Library eBooks Now Available for Kindle®

Exciting news! Amazon's Kindle® has launched the feature that allows Kindle users to borrow Kindle books from their local library! The good news was announced in mid-September. Any generation Kindle now works with Overdrive, the system that libraries use to make eBooks available for borrowing. Over 11,000 U.S. libraries will offer Kindle titles and the Preble County District Library is among them. Also, the features that Kindle users have come to love will be available for their library eBooks, features such as Whispersync, Read Everywhere, Real Page Numbers, Facebook and Twitter Integration, and Wireless delivery.

Borrowing a Kindle book from your library couldn't be easier. Simply go to the Ohio eBook Project (OEP) at <http://ohdbks.lib.overdrive.com> and sign into your account (choose Preble County District Library from the drop down box, then type in your library card number and PIN.) Return to the

OEP Home page, select 'Kindle Books' from the list of formats under 'View All'. Then check out up to ten Kindle books.

When you confirm check out and click 'Get for Kindle,' the user will be re-directed to the

Amazon.com website for the download process to be completed (you will need your Amazon login and password).

Now, you can download library eBooks on a PC, MAC, eReader (including the Nook, Kindle, and Sony eReaders), Android, iPhone, BlackBerry, Windows Phone 7, Windows Mobile, iPad, and/or the iPodtouch. Depending on the device you use, you can download MP3, WMA, EPUB, or PDF files; Kindle books; videos; and music. It couldn't be more convenient.

We have **Storytime on Mondays at 11:00 in West Manchester** and **Tuesdays at 11:00 at Eldorado**. Storytime will be offered again in January.

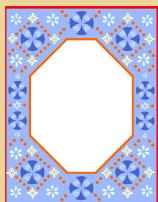
