



Coloring Art Coasters

Adult Craft by Miss Emily at the Eaton Branch

Every month until the end of the year, we will have a different grab and go craft for adults. For September, you will be combining wooden sticks, glue and a coloring book page of your choice to make a really cool coaster!

You will need:

- A page from a coloring book
- Your coloring medium of choice (markers, colored pencils, crayons)
- 10-20 Popsicle sticks (depends on whether you want to make individual or double layered coasters)
- Glue (regular glue will work for putting the coaster together; Mod Podge will be brushed over your illustration once it is glued to the coaster)



Directions:

1. Choose the coloring page you want and color in your design(s). (I recommend starting at the center.) Cut out the design(s) once it is colored.
2. Glue the Popsicle sticks together from side to side. If you would like to add another layer to your coaster, make two coasters and then glue them together (see example on page 2)
3. Glue your design to the top of the coaster.
4. Brush Mod Podge over the top of the picture. Let dry.
