### How is your library funded?

The library is funded through the Public Library Fund (PLF), local property tax levy, donations, grants and fees (printing, faxing). The PLF is a percentage of the Ohio General Revenue Fund, funded through state income tax and sales tax.

# OFFERING MORE TO THE COMMUNITY



### Explore & More Adventure Pass Program

In May 2022, PCDL launched the Explore & More Adventure Pass program offering patrons the opportunity to explore educational and cultural experiences with a one-time pass to attractions that would otherwise charge admission. 
